This keeps Al-Anon free of outside influences that might divert us from our primary purpose of supporting families and friends of alcoholics.

The AISGR uses contributions from Al-Anon and Alateen groups and individual members to fund many things, including:

- A phone service staffed by local Al-Anon members that receives inquiries from prospective members, professionals, institutions, and the public, and directs them to the appropriate group and/or District or Coordinator.
- An up-to-date printed and electronic schedule of meetings within our area.

- Regular business meetings, workshops, fund-raising events, and more.
